


NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 2 (the "District") will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, November 7, 2018, at **8:30 a.m.**, at the **William "Bill" Little Pump Station** (aka Pump Station A), **4435 Greystone Way, Sugar Land, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public communication matters, including response to correspondence, authorize presentations to community, preparation and distribution of quarterly newsletter, maintenance of the District's website, and approve related proposals and contracts.
2. Capital Improvement Plan matters and status report, including scheduling, budgeting, and status of capital improvements and major rehabilitation/repair projects, approve materials testing and environmental services proposals and contracts, approve work and task orders, approve design engineering proposals, authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids and solicitation of proposals, review bids and proposals and award contracts, approve pay estimates, time extensions, change orders, and final acceptance, and direct general manager to notify insurance company of acceptance, as appropriate, for the following:
 - A. New storm water pump station.
 - B. Perimeter levee operation and maintenance matters, including levee certification.
 - C. Drainage analysis and Steepbank Creek outfall closure.
